

## Republic Led The Way with 45% of Top 10s

Republic was the top label, accounting for 45% of the year's top 10s (17 songs) and two #1s. Morgan Wallen led the pack with nine Top 10s (eight as a primary artist and one as a featured artist).



#### **Larger Songwriting Teams**

Songwriting teams of five or more writers accounted for 61% of 2025's Top 10s, up notably from 37% in 2024.

Conversely, those credited to a single writer dropped from 10% to 5% of songs, both attributed to Drake ("Nokia" and "Gimme A Hug").



Six primary genres defined the sound of Top 10 hits during the first half of 2025, along with 27 sub-genres and influences, 25 prominent instruments, and seven lyrical themes.



#### **Country Surpasses Hip Hop and Pop**




Country became the leading primary genre in the Hot 100 Top 10 during the first half of 2025, accounting for 29% of entries—a dramatic rise from just 4% in 2021–2022.

This surge was driven largely by Morgan Wallen, who appeared on 9 of the year's 11 Country Top 10s.


#### Retro

Retro influences were present in nearly one-quarter of 2025's Top 10s, with the 1980s standing out as most popular time period for the fifth consecutive year. Notable examples include the #1 hits "Manchild" by Sabrina Carpenter and "Squabble Up" by Kendrick Lamar, the latter heavily sampling Debbie Deb's 1984 song, "When I Hear Music."




#### **More Guitar**

Use of electric guitar skyrocketed from 38% of songs in 2024 to 61% in 2025, it's highest level in over a decade. While nearly half featured a country influence, it was used in other stylistically diverse hits including "A.P.T." by Bruno Mars and ROSE, "Lose Control" by Teddy Swims," and "Anxiety" by Doechii, the latter which includes a guitar sample from Gotye and Kimbra's 2011 hit, "Somebody That I Used To Know."



#### **Less Synth**

While still used in the majority of Top 10 hits, songs featuring synths continued to decline during the first half of 2025, dropping to 61% of songs. This was their lowest level in over a decade.



### A Major Shift


For the first time in a decade, Top 10s in a major key surpassed those in a minor key with a 53%/45% split between them.



#### **Hookier Hits**

Hot 100 Top 10 hits that include a post-chorus "hook center" in their framework rose to 61% of songs in 2025, their highest level in over a decade.

The outro surpassed the vocal break as the most popular post-chorus section for the first time since 2020.



#### Male Leads Rebound

Following a steady decline between 2021 to 2024, male-led Top 10s surged to 66% in 2025. Conversely, female-led songs experienced a sharp drop, falling from 42% in 2024—after four consecutive years of growth—to just 21% in 2025.



#### **Going it Alone**

Songs with a solo lead vocalist continued to rise for the fifth straight year, reaching their highest level in over a decade at 74% of songs.



#### **Looking Inward**

The theme of introspection rose to its highest level in over a decade at 42% of songs. The theme traversed an array of genres and styles, including "Anxiety" by Doechii, "Pink Pony Club" by Chappell Roan, and "Smile" by Morgan Wallen.
